

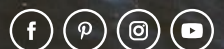

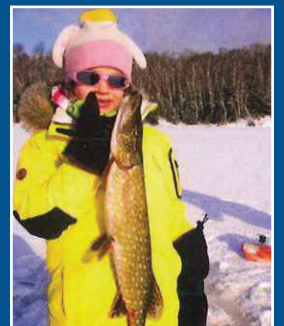



LAKE & WATERWAYS

MAKE WAVES

Natural beauty. It is Vilas County's claim to fame, and much of this beauty resides in the plethora of lakes, rivers, streams and beaches dotting the landscape. Sink your toes in the splendid sandy beaches, paddle through crystal-clear lakes, or sit back and relax in a quiet fishing boat on a secluded lake. Wherever you are called to enjoy the county's many waterways, you will find what you are looking for.



Sun, sand and water aplenty



Beaches

Vilas County features miles of stunning beaches, including some of the best beaches for swimming, sunning and boating. Whether you want to cast a line off a pier, sculpt a sandcastle or simply soak up the sun, the beaches of Vilas County are sure to please.

NICHOLS BEACH PARK & BEACH, BOULDER JUNCTION

A mere 2½ miles from downtown Boulder Junction, Nichols Beach Park & Beach boasts some of the best swimming, picnicking and play areas in the county. To make it a true adventure, why not bike from downtown Boulder Junction, along the Heart of Vilas County Bike Trail, to Nichols Lake Lane. Via car, follow Highway K west, turn left on Highway H and then left onto Nichols Lake Lane. Dogs are welcome here.

EAGLE LAKE COUNTY PARK & BEACH, EAGLE RIVER

Located on the Vilas County's chain of 28 lakes, Eagle Lake County Park & Beach is a four-mile drive northeast of Eagle River. The park is located on the north shore of the 575-acre Eagle Lake and offers plenty of opportunities for bird watching, swimming and beach activities. The park's picnic area is the idea place to fire up the grill for a family picnic, but please note dogs are not allowed.

BRANDY LAKE BEACH, WOODRUFF

A swimming beach with a pier is just one of the many draws of Brandy Lake Beach near Woodruff. The park also boasts a shoreline picnic area, a disc golf course, two baseball fields, two sand volleyball courts, as well as grills and picnic tables aplenty. And in the winter, the ice skating rink offers an idyllic way to celebrate the colder months of the year. Please note that four legged friends are not allowed at this beach.

LITTLE STAR LAKE PARK & BEACH, MANITOWISH WATERS

Located a half-mile west of Highway 51 on Park Road in Manitowish Waters, Little Star Lake is part of the town's 10-lake chain. The park and beach feature a beautiful buoyed swimming beach along with grills and picnic tables — a perfect place to while away the afternoon. Even better, four legged friends are welcome here.

CRYSTAL LAKE PARK & BEACH, SAYNER

If you are looking for a truly picturesque, crystal clear lake for swimming, the Crystal Lake Park and Beach, located in the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest, will fit the bill. Located five miles from downtown Sayner on County N, the beach can also be accessed via the Heart of Vilas County Paved Trail System, making this the ideal combo spot for biking and swimming. Please note that dogs are not allowed in the beach area.

Lake Chains

Whether kayaking, canoeing, paddle boarding or fishing, there are opportunities for all to explore the vast chain of lakes that Vilas County has been blessed with. Nestled along beautiful landscapes teeming with wildlife, these lake chains provide visitors with miles and miles to explore and fish.

CISCO CHAIN

On the northern edge of Vilas County, straddling Wisconsin and Michigan, you will find the famous Cisco Chain of lakes, featuring 15 lakes and 270 miles of shoreline. Considered to be one of the biggest chain of lakes in the world, the Cisco Chain offers opportunities aplenty for boaters to venture into the waters of Wisconsin and Michigan, where clear waters and wildlife abound.

EAGLE RIVER CHAIN

One favorite aspect of the Eagle River Chain is that it seamlessly ushers visitors from one peaceful body of water to another. The fact that it is the largest freshwater chain of lakes in the world simply adds to the majestic beauty of the chain. And thanks to the connection between the Eagle River Chain and the area's Three Lakes Chain, visitors have 28 lakes with 174 miles of shoreline to explore. From May through September a boat hoist helps boaters travel between the two lakes at Burnt Rollways Dam, lifting boats from one chain to the next.

LAC DU FLAMBEAU CHAIN

With 10 lakes, the Lac du Flambeau Chain boasts an abundance of fish and is considered a gem by anglers of all skill levels. The spring-fed lake chain is anchored by Fence Lake, where panfish, musky, smallmouth bass, northern pike and walleye are abundant.

MANITOWISH WATERS CHAIN

This 10-lake chain is another favorite among those looking to cast a line or those eager to enjoy some water recreation. One of the lakes within the Manitowish Waters Chain is Little Star Lake, whose claim to fame revolves around the 1934 shootout involving gangster John Dillinger at Little Bohemia Lodge. Historic tales aside, the Manitowish Waters Chain will offer hours of fun.



PADDLER'S HAVEN

Canoe, kayak, paddleboard — whatever your preference, Vilas County offers some of the best waters for paddling enthusiasts. With thousands of waterbodies in Vilas County, there's no shortage of paddling waters, many of which are quiet with little-to-no traffic. And for those wanting to cover more area, there are miles and miles of rivers and chain lakes to explore. Whether you have just a day or want to make it a multi-day adventure, you'll find a variety of water trails to enjoy. Don't have a board, kayak or canoe? No worries — a number of local outfitters offer rentals.

Fish Frenzy

From first-timers to professionals, Vilas County lakes are the perfect destination for fishing.

Vilas County is home to one of the largest concentrations of freshwater lakes, rivers and streams in the world — that's 1,300 lakes and more than 70 rivers and streams, but who's counting? Many anglers and fishing aficionados looking to get hooked will find a variety of fish species throughout the area. From northern pike to lake trout to walleye, the variety of fish found in the waters of this area make for great opportunities to spend some time on a boat or pier.



Wherever you choose, casting a line in one of the clear, fresh waterways of Vilas County allows both champion anglers and weekend enthusiasts the opportunity to test their skill. Often overlooked, even by sportsmen, are the trout-filled streams and small lakes that grace the landscape of the county.

Or better yet, in an area as renowned for fishing as Vilas County, try your hand at fishing with the help of an experienced guide who can provide great insight into the area's legendary lakes, rivers and streams. Their in-depth knowledge will help you land that elusive musky, or just find a spot where the panfish are biting on a particular day.

Once the lakes freeze over in the winter, ice fishing is the way to go. Today's ice fishing experience is much more than sitting next to a hole, shivering, as you wait for a bite. Bring your shanty (heated, preferably!), grab a beverage and wait for your tip-up to pop!

And for those anglers who consider themselves competitors at heart, check out the large number of fishing tournaments throughout the year in Vilas County. From the annual Frozen Tozen Ice Fishing Tournament in Boulder Junction to the National Muskie Tournament in Eagle River to the Presque Isle Walleye Tournament, the bountiful waters of the Northwoods are the perfect destination for those looking to land the "big one."

TREMOLO – sounds like a quavering laugh and is typically used when loons are disturbed or excited

HOOT – a soft, one-note call loons use in close quarters to call to chicks, mates or even other loons

Whether it's families with kids in tow, couples seeking a relaxing getaway or a group of girlfriends looking to reconnect, our local communities offer an opportunity to escape the hustle and bustle of daily living, and get away to a relaxed atmosphere. In fact, the county is a land of thickly wooded hills, scenic vistas and lakeside retreats. It truly is one of Wisconsin's most scenic getaways that keeps visitors coming back for more each year.

Vilas County creates memories, warm and indelible, with everyone who visits. Whether you're here for a few days or a few weeks, Vilas County offers unique experiences you won't find anywhere else.

So when is the best time to explore all the area has to offer? Truthfully, a visit to Vilas County is perfect in any season, any weather. The four seasons in Vilas County are as distinct as they are beautiful. During each season of the year, Vilas County offers an array of new experiences. Spring features woods and forests teeming with a stunning array of wildflowers. And the lazy days of summer are anything but, with all the hiking, fishing, swimming, boating, shopping and dining opportunities you can imagine. In the autumn, the landscape of Vilas County explodes with brilliant color and when the snow starts flying in the winter, the area offers a wealth of activities for winter enthusiasts. While some visitors select their favorite

season to visit, others embrace the opportunity to celebrate the unique offerings of Vilas County by visiting during each season of the year.



NATURE AWAKENS IN THE SPRING

Perhaps it's the lure of the surrounding countryside or the stunning crystal-clear waters of the 1,300 lakes gracing the area. Or maybe it's the unspoiled beauty of the area's hiking trails or the charming boutiques, antique shops and outdoor markets throughout the county's 12 communities. Whatever it is, the attraction to Vilas County is real. And spring is an ideal time to visit.

In fact, spring is the perfect time to take your bike out of winter storage and explore the Heart of Vilas County Trail System, a National Recreation Trail system that features more than 52 miles of paved trails that connect several communities, including St. Germain, Sayner, Boulder Junction, Manitowish Waters and Mercer. Traverse the trail as it winds through the magnificent Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest and



along the way, riders can get up close and personal with the county's many rivers and lakes. To make it a full-day, pack a lunch and take breaks along the way at the scenic rest areas or enjoy a meal at one of several ride-up restaurants located along the trail. Even better, pack for a longer journey and enjoy the area's campgrounds that are accessible from the trail.

Hikers will revel in the springtime beauty emerging from the landscape of the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest, as the earth reawakens after months of winter dormancy. Here you will experience a stunning array of springtime wildflowers that will literally stop you in your tracks.

Spring is also the ideal time for bird watching, as many of our feathered friends begin to reappear after their long migration journeys. In fact, the bird-rich lake areas of Vilas County attract birders from around the state. Eagles, ospreys, owls, loons, hawks and a variety of other species call this area "home" during the warmer months of the year. The best place to experience the spring migration is at Powell Marsh, located between Manitowish Waters and Lac du Flambeau, where over 200 bird species have been spotted.

SUMMER IS ABOUT THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Summer in Vilas County undoubtedly gets the most fanfare. And what's not to love? The scent of campfires, the sounds of kids splashing in the water and the sight of fireworks over the glorious vistas of the area are just a few of the experiences you'll find during the summer months in Vilas County. Quite simply, summer is the perfect time to enjoy the county with all of its lakes and beaches and beauty.

Aside from fishing, shopping and entertainment aplenty, Vilas County offers the enjoyment of every outdoor recreational activity you can imagine: kayaking, canoeing, windsurfing, hiking, mountain biking, fishing and water skiing. In fact, Vilas County is a dream escape for any outdoor adventurer. The beautiful outdoors simply can't be beat. For nature enthusiasts, summer gardens are in full bloom, wildflowers grace the road sides and there is a leisurely pace that takes hold of all who visit and live in the area.

Summer is also the ideal time to visit local farmers' markets where local products abound, from maple syrup and honey, to homemade jams and veggies.

When it's time to hit the trails — either by land or by waterway — paddlers and hikers alike will be enamored with the vast array of options the county offers. For paddlers who don't mind a portage, or maybe two, explore one (or more) of the five recommended water trails in the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest. The sandy terrain is fairly flat, and permits are not required.



For those going by foot, the trails available are as diverse as the hikers themselves. But be sure to check out the Escanaba-Palette Lake Trails, located just outside of Boulder Junction. Trails range from just over two miles in length to more than eight and wrap around Palette and Escanaba lakes. There is a

small shelter and fire ring. And in the winter, you'll find intermediate-level cross country ski trails.

FALL FOR ADVENTURE

As summer melts into autumn, visitors can ring in the fall season in communities across Vilas County that are celebrating with food and drink, art, music, history, entertainment and more. There's no time like fall to visit Vilas County, as the leaves are changing and the temperatures are cooling. Come October, the annual foliage change is truly a must-see spectacle as the forests and woods are awash in brilliant shades of red, orange and yellow — providing awe-inspiring views at every turn.

For the more adventuresome four-wheel enthusiast types, the Vilas County ATV/UTV route system connects many communities of Vilas County. ATVers can easily explore the area using the free Map It Vilas County trails app, which provides details on the designated paved roads and trails.



And while there may be a chill in the air, the fall season is still a great time to explore the waters of the county via canoe or kayak, or even from a bike. The Manitowish River, near Boulder Junction, explodes in beauty as the leaves change, offering canoers an idyllic way to take in the sights. Bikers can also experience the seasonal change along the WLT-Land O' Lakes Bike Trail or the Conover to Phelps Trail. For a truly unique fall experience, tour one of the area's cranberry marshes and learn how these colorful, tasty treats are grown and harvested. After the full day of adventure, sit down and enjoy the delectable fish fries that are synonymous with the area. A roaring fire, with s'mores aplenty, is the perfect way to round out a fall day in Vilas County.

WINTER IS A WONDERLAND

It's another wonderful time to visit when Jack Frost comes nipping. Here's why: Imagine sitting in a warm, cozy cabin, sipping your steaming coffee as patterns of frost grace the windowpanes, soft layers of snow cover tree branches and the crackling of a warm fire ushers you to curl up with a good book before venturing off into the snowy paradise.

Winter is the ideal time for travelers who love cold weather sports as there are ample opportunities for snowmobiling, snowshoeing, ice fishing, cross-country skiing, skijoring and even fat tire biking. While the days are short and

the snowbanks high, the landscape of Vilas County is undeniably beautiful.

While ice fishing is a popular activity, Vilas County is often celebrated for its snowmobiling opportunities with more than 700 miles of groomed trails. Not to mention, Sayner is considered the birthplace of the snowmobile. The county is also home to both the St. Germain Snowmobiling Hall of Fame and the World Snowmobiling Headquarters in Eagle River.

If going at a slower pace along the snow-packed trails is more appealing, consider donning a pair of snowshoes and hitting the trails at North Lakeland Discovery Center in Manitowish Waters. And as fat tire biking is becoming ever-more popular, biking enthusiasts can explore the well-groomed Winman Trails, located between Winchester and Manitowish Waters.

In Vilas County, visitors typically don't hunker down to avoid Old Man Winter, but if arts and leisure are more your style than hiking through snow-covered trails, be sure to visit many of the galleries located throughout the area. Known as a haven for artisans, you will find wonderful original works in the shops and galleries in these charming towns.

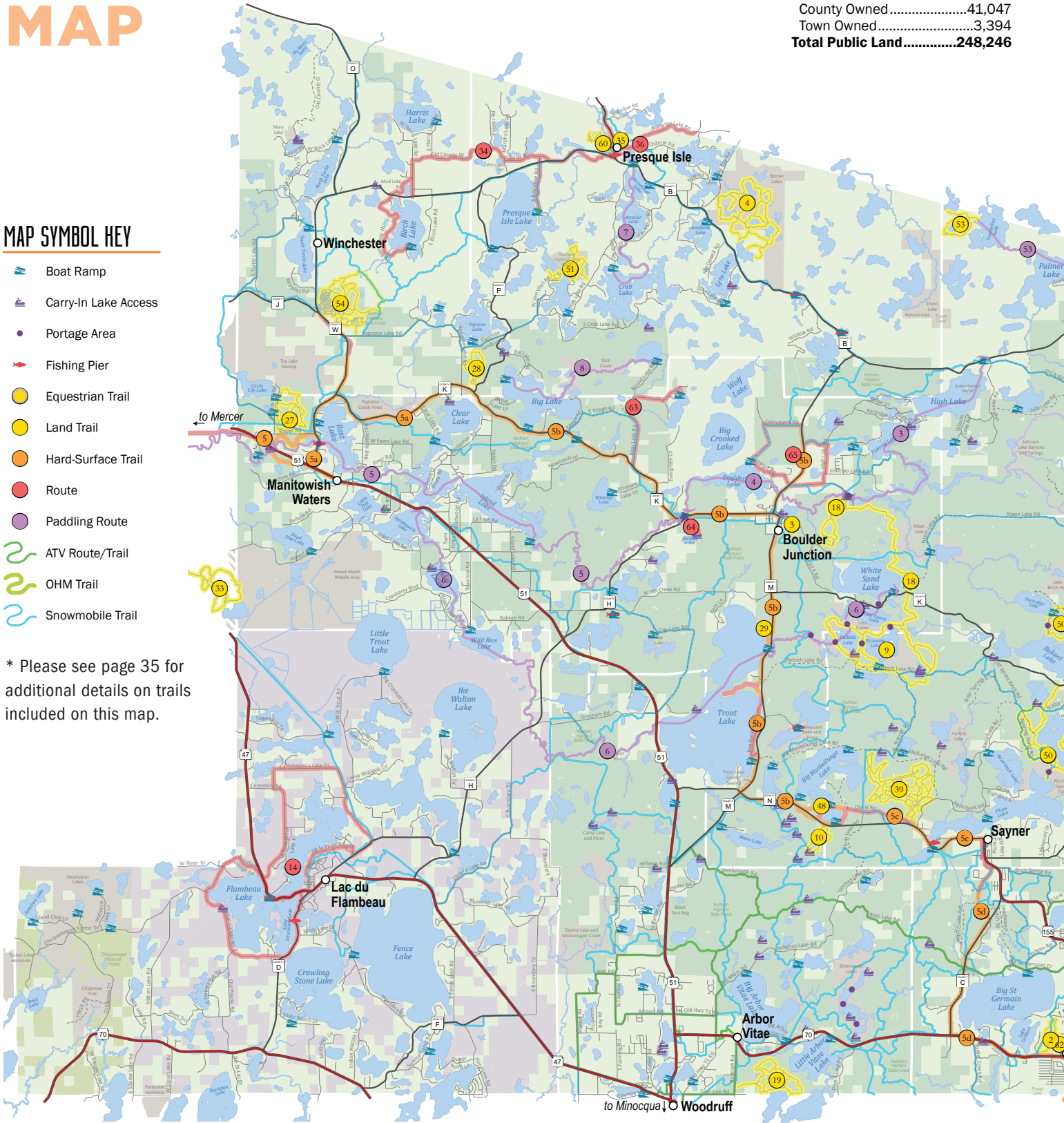

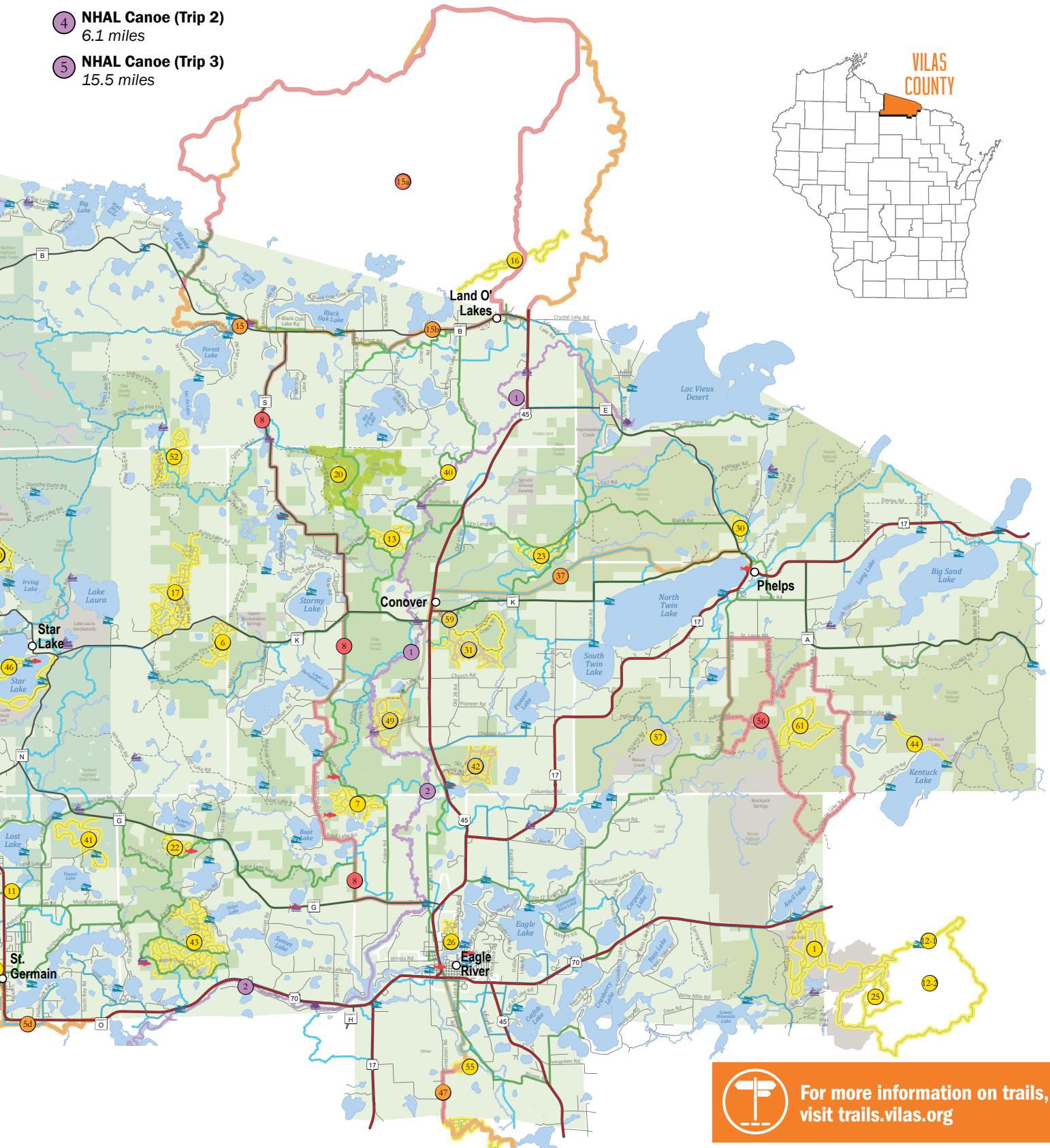

SNOWMOBILE VILAS

Vilas County is one of the world's premier snowmobiling destinations, home to a quarter million acres of public land in the Lake Superior Snowbelt. Explore over 700 miles of spectacular trails that traverse unspoiled wilderness, crossing undeveloped lakes and connecting to scenic Northwoods communities.

Here are a few reminders:

- **Any person born on or after January 1, 1985, is required to complete a safety course and carry a safety certificate.**
- Children under the age of 12 may not operate a snowmobile unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Wear a helmet and appropriate clothing.
- Maintain a safe speed and follow all regulatory trail signs.
- **Going off marked trails is trespassing.**
- Look for the brown Trail Information Numbering Signs at snowmobile intersections.
- Use caution when crossing marked lake trails.
- Never ride alone.
- Know the snowmobile you are riding.
- Alcohol and snowmobiling don't mix.

Map Your Own Adventure

There are hundreds of miles of trails to explore in Vilas County. Our free app is the best way to find and navigate all of them. The Map It Vilas County trails app is unlike any other — it uses GPS mapping technology to help silent and motorsport enthusiasts navigate our vast forests. The app includes nearly 90 trail maps for ATVing/UTVing, biking, birdwatching, cross-country skiing, equestrian, hiking, hunting, off-highway motorcycling, paddling, snowmobiling, snowshoeing and swimming, plus those that are dog friendly. Go to trails.vilas.org to download the app, which is also available in the Google and iPhone app stores.

BACKCOUNTRY SNOWSHOEING

The app will help you make tracks into the wilderness. One popular backcountry route is the 13-mile Hidden Lakes Trail, located near Eagle River.

OFF-HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLING

If you're a rider who likes to get a little dirt on your tires, you'll find 14 miles of great riding on the Tamaracks Off-Highway Motorcycling Trail in Conover.

BACKCOUNTRY PADDLING

The headwaters of the state's largest river, the Wisconsin, can be found just east of Land O' Lakes at Lac Vieux Desert. If you're willing to portage an occasional beaver dam, it's an unforgettable paddling trip. On the app, look for WI Centennial Trail - Trip 1 — it's one of seven paddling routes detailed on the Map It app.

HISTORIC SNOWMOBILING

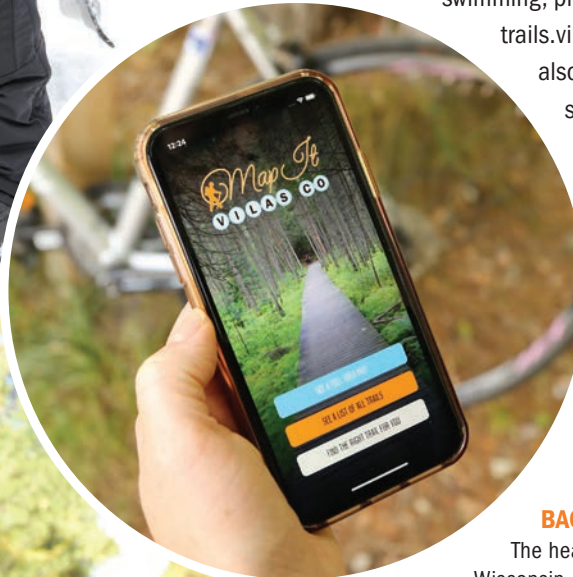
Sayner-Star Lake is the birthplace of the snowmobile, and the Sayner-Star Lake Barnstormers have been grooming trails here for 50 years. The app will help you find Trail 51, a forest route near Sayner-Star Lake that's one of the state's oldest snowmobile trails.

EQUESTRIAN TRAILS

The Vilas County Equestrian trail system provides over 16 miles of equestrian trails via three loops: the Pioneer Creek Trail, Ski Hills Trails and Torch Lake Trails.

ATV/UTV

Vilas County is home to several ATV/UTV routes, including some easy-riding trails in Conover, Phelps, Land O' Lakes, St. Germain, Eagle River and the Minocqua Area. These routes, usually open from early May to the end of October, connect to other area trails and routes to the east and west.

Here are a few reminders:

- Be predictable and visible.
- Use clear hand signals.
- Use lights at night.
- Be considerate.
- Always wear a helmet.

ATV/UTV VILAS

Enjoy a safe ATV/UTV ride in Vilas County.

Here are a few reminders:

- **Anyone born on or after January 1, 1988 is required to carry a safety certificate.**
- Children aged 12-15 must have an ATV Safety Certificate and be accompanied by an adult while operating on an ATV route.
- All children under age 18 must wear an ATV or motorcycle helmet and goggles.
- No ATV operators under age 12 and no UTV operators under 16 may operate on a public roadway.
- All UTV passengers must wear safety restraints.
- **Off-trail riding is trespassing.**
- ATVs/UTVs must have their headlamps on at all times.
- Alcohol and riding don't mix.
